

What does PBIS look like at Ligon?

At the beginning of the school year, Ligon staff and students took 3 days to learn and review the ROAR expectations at Ligon. At the same time we introduced Class Dojo as the reward system for the students this year. When a student exhibits ROAR, then any staff can award a student a Dojo point from any device. Then every quarter staff and students review the ROAR expectations through a PBIS reset. During this time the PBIS team identified areas that still need improvement and we review the expectations through scenarios, practice and discussions. On the positive side, students are rewarded daily with Dojo points. They can use their dojo points at the Dojo concessions to purchase fun things like a homework pass or lunch outside with a friend. There is also several larger rewards such as double lunch, movie day and March Madness.

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




It's all in the Data
