Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Registration

AP Exam registration ends on February 24. Register now. Late registrations will not be accepted. Follow the registration directions on the website. Payments/forms must be dropped off in Student Services before school, after school or during lunch only. Students should register [here](#). Students must register for each exam they will take. Fees will be waived for courses offered and taken at LRHS. Students must pay the \$93 exam fee for courses not taught taken at LRHS. Examples include Chinese, French, German, Microeconomics, and Physics C: Mechanics. Contact Mrs. Swann at dswann@wcpss.net for more information.

Student Services Updates

- **2017-2018 Class Registration**-The counselors have begun meeting with all juniors, sophomores and freshmen to assist them in choosing classes for the 2017-2018 school year. Students will come home with a copy of their transcript, a graduation checklist, and a “rough draft” course list where they have identified the classes and alternates they may enter into PowerSchool. Students have until February 28 to enter their classes into PowerSchool. Detailed information about the registration process can be found on the school’s website. - **Junior Meetings**-The counselors will meet with all of their junior students in small groups in March. During these meetings the counselors will share information about college and career planning.
- **Sophomore Meetings**-The counselors will meet with all sophomores in small groups before Spring Break. The lesson will be in a computer lab and will focus on researching post-secondary education options, and reminders on credit totals and promotion requirements.
- **ACT for Juniors**-All juniors will take the ACT with writing for free during the regular school day on Tuesday, February 28. The students do not need to register. For ACT prep go to: <http://www.act.org/content/act/en/products-and-services/the-act/test-preparation.html>
- **Financial Aid Assistance**-Just a reminder that Ann Humphrey, our financial aid counselor, is still with us one day a week through the middle of April to assist with completion of the Federal Financial Aid application. Parents may contact the Student Services Office to make an appointment.
