- The top 5 winners of the classroom bees will participate in the grade bees, which will be held the week ending November 17th (specific date TBD).
- The top 5 winners of the grade level bees will participate in the school bee on December 18th. (January 8, 2018 is the back-up school-wide date. Our winner must be determined by January 31st, 2018 for them to be eligible for the Wake County Bee in March.)
- The winner of the school bee will represent Root ES at the PAGE of Wake County Regional Bee on March 17, 2018

Please return your child's form to school no later than September 29, 2017 to give your child plenty of time to learn the words. Also, please let your child know that they have been enrolled, so that Mrs. T can make sure to get the study words to them!!
